SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2 ENTRIES

Competitors may enter by delivering a completed entry form and paying the \$40 entry fee to the Kenosha Yacht Club before 10:30am on Saturday July 9th 2011.

3 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located at <http://www.kenoshayachtclub.com>

4 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

Signals made ashore will be displayed from the flagpole located at the Kenosha Yacht Club. If a postponement is signaled ashore, the warning signal will be made not less than 30 minutes after flag AP is lowered.

5 SCHEDULE and CLASS FLAG(S)

The skippers meeting will be held at the Kenosha Yacht Club Deck, Saturday July 9th. The warning signal for the first race on 7/10/2009 will be at 10:55am. The warning signal for the first race on 7/10 will be at 9:55am. Subsequent races each day will be held as soon as possible after the end of the previous race. Class Flags will be assigned at the Skippers Meeting.

6 RACING AREA

The racing area will be approximately 1 mile East of the Port of Kenosha.

7 COURSE[S] and MARKS

The course[s] will be set as diagramed below. The course will be designated by a black letter on a white board. All marks will be Inflatable buoys. The attached diagram shows the courses, course designations, the marks in order and the rounding direction of each mark.

8 STARTING AND FINISHING LINES; STARTING SYSTEM]

The starting and finishing lines will be between the Race committee and a buoy designated as the pin end. The Race Committee may float a safety buoy off her stern.

9 TIME LIMIT

The time limit for each race will be 90 minutes for the first boat to finish. After the first boat finishes the remaining competitors will have 30 minutes to finish.

10 PROTESTS

Protests shall be delivered to the Principal Race Officer within 30 minutes after the race committee boat docks. The protest time limit and a list of protests received will be posted on the notice board. Hearings will be held as soon as possible after racing each day at the Kenosha Yacht Club.

11 SCORING

6 races are scheduled. If at least 5 races are completed, each boat's worst score will be excluded from her series score. One race constitutes a series.

12 RADIO COMMUNICATION

The Race Committee will use VHF Channel 69 for courtesy announcements.



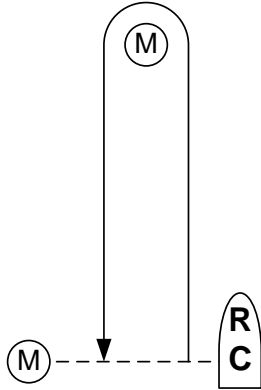

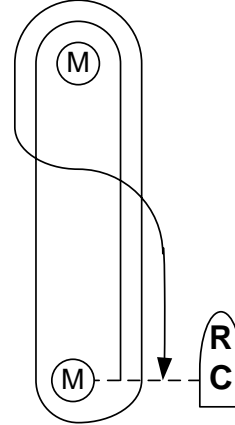


Race Courses

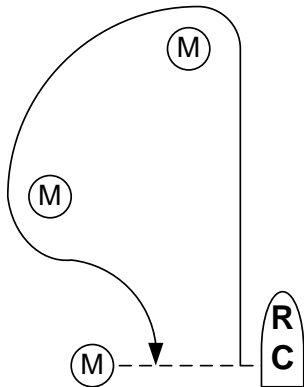
Windward 1 "W1"



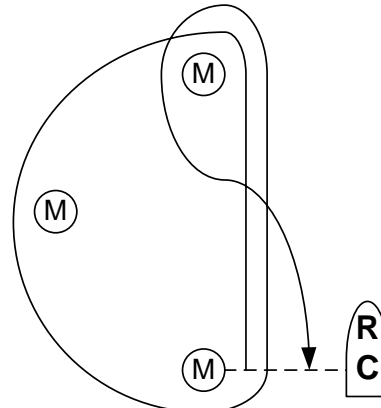
Windward 2 "W2"
